

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Clay Township Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on September 26, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the agenda allows, at the Township Hall, 4710 Pte. Tremble Road, Clay Township.

The purpose of the meeting will be to receive comments on an application for a special land use approval for an attached business district accessory dwelling unit located at 2669 Columbine Road in Clay Township. The applicant wishes to construct a residential unit off the back of an existing storage barn on the property that serves the Schoolhouse Grille.

This hearing is authorized by Township Ordinance No. 126 and State of Michigan PA 110 of 2006.

This application may be reviewed at the Clay Township Hall, 4710 Pte. Tremble Road, Monday through Thursday, during regular business hours. The public is encouraged to attend this hearing and offer relevant comments. Interested citizens may also submit written comments to the Township Hall, to the attention of the Zoning Administrator, until 6:00 p.m. on the day of the hearing.
