2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being section 125.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subject to civil fines.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Clay Township Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code.

No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

Clay Township Building Department's telephone number will be provided on the issued permit. Please call at least 24 hours in advance when ready for inspections.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT OR WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

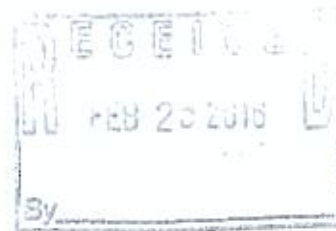

Dear Valued DTE Electric Company partner,

Beginning March 1st all new, upgraded or relocated DTE Electric Company residential service lines must be installed underground. On Dec. 11, 2015, the Michigan Public Service Commission approved tariff language implementing these new provisions. The tariff language reads: *"All new, relocated or upgraded residential service connections will be installed as underground residential service laterals at the customer's expense."* Exceptions may be permitted by DTE Electric Company for loads of a temporary period or if found impractical to be built. These changes are effective and will be reflected on DTE Electric Company's ESIG webpage on March 1, 2016.

It's important that both builders and residential customers understand that overhead service lines cannot be installed after March 1 and that all residential service lines will be installed underground. Please communicate this information within your organization to ensure the awareness of this change.
